



Invitation for Pre-qualification

For

Tender for Re-print and Supply of Bank of Tanzania Notes

1. This invitation for prequalification follows the General Procurement Notice for this procurement that appeared on various newspapers dated **4th July, 2016**.
2. The Bank of Tanzania during the Financial Year **2016/2017** has set aside funds for the cost of **Re-print and Supply of Bank of Tanzania Notes**. The Bank of Tanzania intends to pre-qualify applicants for Re-print of Bank of Tanzania Notes. It is expected that invitations of the tender will be made in **July, 2017**.
3. Pre-qualification will be conducted through the procedures specified in Regulation 119 of the Public Procurement (Regulations – Government Notice 446 of 2013) and is open to all Applicants as defined in the Regulations. **Applicants will be required to demonstrate their products and capabilities at the Bank premises after submission of applications on a date to be communicated later.**
4. Interested applicants may obtain further information from and inspect the pre-qualification documents at the office of the **Secretary, Bank of Tanzania Tender Board, 2 Mirambo Street, 2nd Floor, South Tower from 8.30 am-4.30 pm on Monday to Friday except on public holidays** before the deadline for the submission of applications.
5. A complete set of pre-qualification documents in English may be obtained **Free of Charge** by interested Applicants on the submission of a written application to the address given under paragraph 4 above.
6. All applications should be submitted as one **original plus two (2)** copies properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes and be delivered to the address in para 4 above at or before **6th June, 2017 at 11.00 am**. Applications will be opened promptly thereafter in public and in the presence of Applicants' representatives who choose to attend the opening at the the Bank of Tanzania, Prospective Banking Hall, Ground Floor, South Tower, 2 Mirambo Street

7. Late applications, portion of applications, electronic applications, and applications not received, applications not opened and not read out in public at the opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
