



MWALIMU JULIUS NYERERE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND

2017/18 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The Mwalimu Julius Nyerere Memorial Scholarship Fund, an endowment Fund was established by the Bank of Tanzania (BOT) on 12th October, 2009 to commemorate the great achievements of the Late Father of our Nation, Mwalimu Julius Kambarage Nyerere.

The primary objective of the Fund is to promote interest and excellence in **Mathematics and Science studies among female students** in the United Republic of Tanzania. It is dedicated to sponsor female Tanzanian top performers in the Advanced Certificate of Secondary Education Examinations (ACSEE) to pursue undergraduate studies in Mathematics and Science studies in accredited universities within the United Republic of Tanzania.

The Fund is also used to sponsor both male and female top performers in the ACSEE to pursue undergraduate degree programmes in Economics, Information Technology, Accounting and Finance as well as top performers in undergraduate studies intending to pursue Master's degree programmes in those fields.

The Fund began granting Scholarships effective from 2013/14 academic year. To date it has granted a total of thirty-four (34) Scholarships to qualified candidates for Undergraduate and Master's studies in accredited universities within the United Republic of Tanzania.

For the academic year 2017/18, the Fund has awarded Scholarships to six (6) top students following a rigorous selection process based on established criteria. The selected candidates for Undergraduate studies are top performers from the best ten (10) students of the 2017 ACSEE, with Division One and Consistent High Academic Performance. The Scholarship recipients for Master's degree programmes have First Class Bachelor degrees.
